The Committees will resume deliberations on the following proposed resolutions:

- **PROPOSED SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 313** – RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE NEED TO PROMOTE ZERO TOURISM WASTE POLICY (*Introduced by Senator Binay*);
- **PROPOSED SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 393** – RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON TOURISM TO INVESTIGATE IN AID OF LEGISLATION THE ALLEGED DEGRADATION AND POLLUTION OF PRIME ISLAND BEACH DESTINATIONS AND OTHER COASTAL RECREATION WATERS IN THE COUNTRY WITH THE END VIEW OF CRAFTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS TO PROTECT AND CONSERVE OUR BEACHES, SHORELINES AND OTHER ECO-TOURISM SITES (*Introduced by Senator Ejercito*);
- **PROPOSED SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 633** – RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE SEVERE POLLUTION IN BORACAY WITH THE END VIEW OF FORMULATING POLICIES TO ADDRESS THE ISLANDS DETERIORATING STATE, PROTECT ITS ENVIRONMENT AND ECOLOGY, AND PROMOTE ITS SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (*Introduced by Senator Angara*);
- **PROPOSED SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 640** – RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE RAMPANT NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS BY NUMEROUS BORACAY ESTABLISHMENTS AND RESIDENTS AS WELL AS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS THEREBY CONTRIBUTING TO THE DETERIORATING ECOLOGICAL CONDITION OF THE ISLAND AND COMPROMISING BORACAY'S POSITION AS ONE OF THE PRIME TOURISTS ATTRACTIONS IN THE PHILIPPINES (*Introduced by Senator Villar*);
- **PROPOSED SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 646** – RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES AND OTHER APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE, TO INQUIRE AND REVIEW, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, THE PROCEDURES FOR THE APPROVAL AND MONITORING OF ENVIRONMENTALLY CRITICAL PROJECTS (*Introduced by Senator Villanueva*); and
- **PROPOSED SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 14** – RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO LEAD THE CONDUCT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT OF RELEVANT NATIONAL AGENCIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS IN RELATIONS TO THEIR COMPLIANCE TO EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS IN LIGHT OF THE CONTINUED ECOSYSTEMS DECLINE AND ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION WITH THE END VIEW OF INTRODUCING MEASURABLE INDICATORS AND TARGETS AND ENCOURAGING PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY OF ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS (*Introduced by Senator Legarda*)

- **SENATE BILL NO. 423** – AN ACT TO ADOPT INTEGRATED COASTAL MANAGEMENT AS A NATIONAL STRATEGY TO ENSURE THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF THE COASTAL AND MARINE ENVIRONMENT AND TO ESTABLISH SUPPORTING MECHANISMS FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION (*Introduced By Senator Legarda*);
- **SENATE BILL NO. 471** – AN ACT ESTABLISHING POLICY MECHANISM FOR THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND USE OF THE ISLAND OF BORACAY, MUNICIPALITY OF MALAY, PROVINCE OF AKLAN, DEFINING FOR THE PURPOSE THE MODE OF ACQUISITION FOR PARCELS OF LAND WITHIN THE ISLAND CLASSIFIED AS AGRICULTURAL LAND OPEN TO DISPOSITION UNDER PROCLAMATION NO. 1064 AND PROVIDING ENVIRONMENTAL SAFEGUARDS THEREFOR (*Introduced by Senator Trillanes IV*);
- **SENATE BILL NO. 593** – AN ACT PRESCRIBING EVERY SECOND SUNDAY OF SEPTEMBER AS A NATIONAL COASTAL CLEAN-UP DAY IN THE COUNTRY (*Introduced by Senator Trillanes IV*);
- **SENATE BILL NO. 1687** – INSTITUTIONALIZING SUSTAINABLE COASTAL TOURISM, PROVIDING MECHANISMS FOR ITS INSTITUTIONALIZATION, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES (*Introduced by Senator Poe*); and
- **SENATE BILL NO. 1756** – AN ACT CREATING THE BORACAY ISLAND COUNCIL. (*Introduced by Senator Drilon*).
