Please be informed that the Committee on Public Services will conduct a public hearing on **November 15, 2018 (Thursday), 10:00 a.m.** at **Performing Arts Theater (PAT) 6F Engineering Complex University of Science & Technology Southern Philippines, Cagayan de Oro City**, on the following:

1. **Senate Resolution No. 736** entitled "RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SERVICES AND OTHER APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE VARIOUS PUBLIC UTILITIES INCLUDING GAS, TRANSPORT, ELECTRICITY AND WATER AS THEY ARE AFFECTED BY THE INITIAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 'TRAIN LAW' WITH THE OBJECTIVES OF SUBMITTING REMEDIAL MEASURES, STRENGTHENING SUBSIDIES AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, IF NEEDED AND RECOMMENDING OTHER APPROACHES TO HELP AFFECTED FILIPINO FAMILIES" (Introduced by **Senator Grace Poe**);
2. **Senate Resolution No. 910** entitled "RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SERVICES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE REPORTS BY PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE (PUV) DRIVERS AND OPERATORS IN VARIOUS PROVINCES OF THE COUNTRY THAT THE PENALTIES UNDER DOTR-LTFRB-LTO JOINT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2014-01 ARE UNJUSTLY HARSH, AND SEVERELY IN EXCESS OF THOSE PROVIDED UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 4136, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 'LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRAFFIC CODE', IN RECOGNITION OF THE WIDELY-ACCEPTED LEGAL PRINCIPLE THAT IMPLEMENTING RULES AND

REGULATIONS MUST NOT OVERRIDE, SUPPLANT, OR MODIFY WHAT IS PROVIDED IN LAW, AS THAT WOULD CONSTITUTE AN INVALID ENCROACHMENT BY THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH INTO THE LEGISLATIVE POWER VESTED BY THE CONSTITUTION IN BOTH HOUSES OF CONGRESS.” (Introduced by **Senator Grace Poe**); and

3. **Senate Resolution No. 819** entitled “RESOLUTION URGING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SERVICES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, INTO THE STATUS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE MODERNIZATION PROGRAM (PUVM) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOTR), WITH THE END GOALS OF CRAFTING MEASURES PRIORITIZING EXISTING DRIVERS AND/OR OPERATORS OF PUVS, ENSURING REALISTIC AND DOABLE TERMS AND REGULATIONS FOR THEIR COMPLIANCE AND STRENGTHENING CHECKS AND BALANCES TO WEED OUT CORRUPTION IN THE MODERNIZATION PROCESS.” (Introduced by **Senator Grace Poe**).
